John Argoudelis acting as chairman and Anita Gerardy acting as Town Clerk, the following official business was transacted:

- I. Meeting April 25, 2012** was called to order at **6:05 p.m.**
- II. Pledge of Allegiance and Prayer**  
Pledge of Allegiance and Prayer were said.
- III. Roll Call for Quorum:** Ken McCafferty –Absent, Chuck Willard- Present, Steve Cammack – Present, Tony Fremarek- Present, John Argoudelis-Present.
- IV. Approval of Agenda:** A motion to approve the agenda was made by Tony Fremarek, seconded by Chuck Willard. Voice vote taken. Motion carries.
- V. Supervisor’s Report**
  - A. Mechanical/Heating/Plumbing Discussion:** Jacob Been, Healy Bender Senior Associate, presented the board with layouts of the addition that were adjusted after his meeting with Andi French and Kathy Whalen. Mr. Been stated he has been in contact with the County regarding the parking spaces and stated we are not required to add any additional parking spaces but we are required to allocate five handicapped parking spaces. Supervisor Argoudelis stated the original concept drawing added handicapped parking in front of the building but since it will no longer be needed, it would free up money that could be applied to the mechanical, heating and plumbing costs. Mr. Been presented five potential options for the mechanical/heating and plumbing from Millies Engineering Group. Trustee Willard questioned the possibility of installing a sprinkler system in the new building as well as the existing building. Supervisor Argoudelis stated the budget includes the installation of a sprinkler system only in the addition. The board reviewed the proposals and after much discussion a motion was made by Trustee

Fremarek to go with option two and option four. Supervisor Argoudelis called for a second to the motion, no motion was made. Supervisor Argoudelis declared the motion failed for lack of a second. A motion was then made by Trustee Cammack to accept option one and option four with the understanding that we have additional funds in the budget from the design contingency and the parking lot and any other areas where the budget can be trimmed so the overall budget is not increased, motion was seconded by Trustee Willard. Roll call taken: Steve Cammack-Aye, Chuck Willard-Aye, Tony Fremarek-Nay, John Argoudelis-Aye. Motion carries. Mr. Cammack made an adjustment to the motion to move into construction phase, seconded by Tony Fremarek. Voice vote taken. Motion carries.

**B. Building Server Repair/Replace:** Supervisor Argoudelis stated RWK advised him the server had a catastrophic failure and according to RWK, it would be approximately \$8,000.00 to \$10,000.00 to get a hard body network server upgrade of what we currently have or go to a cloud based system. Trustee Fremarek advised the board to go with a virtualized system which would give us the advantage of security, regular backups, and easier maintenance. He stated we will not have another catastrophic failure should we go to a cloud based virtualized system. Trustee Willard made a motion to go to a virtualized cloud based system, seconded by Trustee Fremarek. Roll call: Tony Fremarek-Aye, Steve Cammack-Aye, Chuck Willard-Aye, John Argoudelis-Aye. Motion carries.

**C. Ad for Park District Booklet-Draft:** Ms. French presented the board with three different designs. After discussing the three drawings, Supervisor Argoudelis suggested a motion to accept number one with the modification of moving the Community Services portion of the drawing to the top of the page with the Elected Official's names moved to the bottom of the page. Trustee Willard made a motion to accept number one with the modifications suggested by the Supervisor seconded by Trustee Cammack. Voice vote taken. Motion carries.

**VI. Public Comments:** Colleen Stueckrad, a Plainfield Township resident, advised the board the street light on River Road by her house has been taken down and moved to the driveway on the other side of the curve. The curve is now dark at night. Supervisor Argoudelis asked Ms. French to advise Sam Reichert to look into correcting this problem.

**Budget:** Supervisor Argoudelis stated Ms. French will update the budget with changes that were made at the workshop. She will e-mail the changes to everyone. If you have any comments on the update, please e-mail her with your concerns.
