ORDINANCE NO. 11-04
PLAINFIELD TOWNSHIP ROAD & BRIDGE DISTRICT
AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING PREVAILING WAGE STANDARDS

WHEREAS, the State of Illinois has enacted "An Act regulating wages of laborers, mechanics and other workers employed in any public works by the State, county, city or any public body or any political subdivision or by any one under contract for public works," approved June 26, 1941, as amended (Illinois Compiled Statutes, (820 ILCS 130/1 et.seq.) as amended and

WHEREAS, the aforesaid Act requires that the Highway Commissioner of the Township of Plainfield investigate and ascertain the prevailing rate of wages as defined in said Act for laborers, mechanics and other workers in the locality of said Plainfield Township employed in performing construction of public works, for said Plainfield Township.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY the Highway Commissioner of Plainfield Township:

SECTION 1: To the extent and as required by "An Act regulating wages of laborers, mechanics and other workers employed in any public works by State, county, city or any public body or any political subdivision or by any one under contract for public works," approved June 26, 1941, as amended, the general prevailing rate of wages in this locality for laborers, mechanics and other workers engaged in construction of public works coming under the jurisdiction of the Road & Bridge District of Plainfield Township is hereby ascertained to be the same as the prevailing rate of wages for construction work in the Will County area as determined by the Department of Labor of the State of Illinois as of June of the current year a copy of that determination being attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference. As required by said Act, any and all revisions of the prevailing rate of wages by the Department of Labor of the State of Illinois shall supersede the Department's June determination and apply to any and all public works construction undertaken by the Road & Bridge District of Plainfield Township. The definition of any terms appearing in this Ordinance which are also used in aforesaid Act shall be the same as in said Act.

SECTION 2: Nothing herein contained shall be construed to apply said general prevailing rate of wages as herein ascertained to any work or employment except public works of the Road & Bridge District of Plainfield Township to the extent required by the aforesaid Act.

SECTION 3: The Plainfield Township Clerk shall publicly post or keep available for inspection by any interested party in the main office of the Township this determination or any revisions of such prevailing rate of wage. A copy of this determination or of the current revised determination of prevailing rate of wages then in effect shall be attached to all contract specifications.

Ordinance No. 11-02

An ordinance appropriating for all road purposes for **PLAINFIELD TOWNSHIP ROAD DISTRICT**, Will County, Illinois, for the fiscal year beginning **April 1, 2011** and ending **March 31, 2012**.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of **PLAINFIELD TOWNSHIP**, Will County, Illinois.

SECTION 1: That the amounts hereinafter set forth, or so much thereof as may be authorized by law, and so may be needed or deemed necessary to defray all expenses and liabilities of Plainfield Township Road District, Will County, Illinois, as hereinafter specified for the fiscal year beginning **April 1, 2011** and ending **March 31, 2012**.

SECTION 4: That if any section, subdivision, or sentence of this ordinance shall for any reason be held invalid or to be unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion of this ordinance.

SECTION 5: That each appropriated fund total shall be divided among the several objects and purposes specified, and in particular amounts stated for each fund respectively in Section 2 constituting the total appropriations in the amounts of **one million, nine hundred eighty thousand, four hundred two dollars (1,980,402)**, for the fiscal year beginning April 1, 2011 and ending March 31, 2012.


SECTION 6: That Section 3 shall be and is a summary of the annual Appropriation Ordinance of this Road District, passed by the Board of Trustees as required by law and shall be in full force and effect from and after this date.

SECTION 7: That a certified copy of the Budget and Appropriation Ordinance shall be filed with the County Clerk within 30 days after adoption.
